DESCRIPTION

The design-build team of LS3P (formerly ENB) architects & Auld & White Constructors was retained by the City of Jacksonville to construct its new Animal Care & Protective Services facility. The project achieved the city's first LEED Gold certification, emphasizing sustainability. The design incorporates eco-friendly elements like a cool roof, an energy-efficient HVAC system, and intelligent use of natural light. Recycled materials and low-emission adhesives/paints were used, along with water-saving plumbing and drought-resistant landscaping. During construction, an impressive 94.7% of waste was diverted from landfills, showcasing a commitment to reducing environmental impact. This facility isn't just about caring for animals; it's also a testament to how responsible building practices can make a difference for our planet.
