DESCRIPTION

Auld & White Constructors was retained by the City of Jacksonville to complete the design-build of Fire Station #40. The new two-story, free-standing fire station, consisting of structural steel, poured concrete, a composite deck second floor, a bar joist & metal deck roof structure, and a 12" concrete tilt-panel wall system, was designed to withstand 150-mph winds at three-second gusts and the wave action created by a 14' storm surge. This land and marine-based facility is used as a post storm operations and search & rescue center. This fire station is LEED certified.
