

## DESCRIPTION

Auld & White Constructors (AWC) was retained to provide construction services for the renovation of the JEA Westside Service Center administrative area. The project included renovation & infrastructure upgrades of the existing 1969 structure to meet current needs and industry standards. The new design included the installation of additional exterior windows to increase the amount of daylight into the building and to provide personnel with views to the exterior.

AWC was initially contracted to be substantially complete in October 2020. JEA later decided they wanted the facility to be open prior to the start of hurricane season. Through strategic project management, AWC was able to accelerate the schedule by two (2) months enabling early occupancy for this critical "essential facility" in advance of one of the busiest hurricane seasons in history.





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
